What is Elizabeth Ministry?

Elizabeth Ministry is a one-on-one woman to woman ministry to support all the joys, challenges and sorrows of the childbearing years and beyond. Our mission is to cherish children, encourage families, and build community.

How does it work?

Volunteers mentor other women in the areas they have experienced. A volunteer mother of twins mentors a woman pregnant with twins, for example. Support is given through visits, cards, letters, prayers, phone calls, email, and other resources and assistance.



What areas are included?

The areas of Elizabeth ministry include (but are not limited to) pregnancy, birth, miscarriage, stillbirth, regretted abortions, infant death, special needs, crisis situations, adoption, infertility, and blended families

Who are Elizabeth Ministers?

Elizabeth Ministers are not counselors, but are volunteers who are willing to share their presence, stories and experience as peer support, mentoring, and friendship.

What can I do to help?

You can become an Elizabeth Minister. (there is no training needed to be someone's friend) You can make baby bonnets, quilts, afghans, etc. to give to the Mom and Baby. You can share what you know and your resources. You can contact us and ask what is needed.
